

Ordinance No. 2022-06

City of Stockport – Summary of Ordinance #2022-06

The City Council of the City of Stockport, Iowa, adopted Ordinance #2022-06 at its regularly scheduled City Council meeting held on June 6, 2022. The content of the Ordinance is summarized in its title as follows:

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE 4, CHAPTER 1 SECTION 9 ANIMAL CONTROL – KEEPING A VICIOUS DOG OR CAT (4-1-9) OF THE CITY OF STOCKPORT MUNICIPAL CODEBOOK OF ORDINANCES. It shall be unlawful for any person or persons to harbor or keep a vicious dog or cat within the City. A vicious cat or dog is deemed so when it shall have attacked or bitten any person or animal (without provocation), or when the propensity to attack or bite persons shall exist and such propensity is known or ought reasonably be known to the owner thereof. If a complaint has been filed for a vicious dog or cat, the City will notify the Van Buren County Sheriff’s office. The effective date of the Ordinance is June 15, 2022.
