City of Stockport – Summary of Ordinance #2022-05

The City Council of the City of Stockport, Iowa, adopted Ordinance #2022-06 at its regularly scheduled City Council

meeting held on June 6, 2022. The content of the Ordinance is summarized in its title as follows:

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE 4, CHAPTER 1 SECTION 3 ANIMAL CONTROL – ENTITLED OF THE CITY OF STOCKPORT MUNICPAL CODEBOOK OF ORDINANCES. No owner or person having custody of an animal shall permit such animal to run at large. A written complaint received by City Hall will result in a letter immediately sent to the property owner informing them of the ordinance violation and the consequences if subsequent complaints are filed for the same animal. If a second complaint is received after the first offense letter has been sent to the owner a \$25 fine will be issued for the second offense; \$50 for a third offense; and \$100 for each offense thereafter. If these fines are not paid within thirty days of issuance the amounts will be assessed to the owner's property taxes. The effective date of the Ordinance is June 15, 2022.
