Motion by Clark, seconded by Padget authorizing Clerk Cain to obtain state notary credentials for City business. Motion carried.

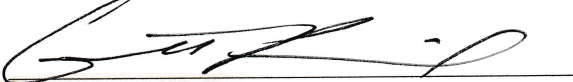
Training and Reimbursements

Motion by Padgett, seconded by Schuck directing Clerk Cain to prepare and send a letter regarding animal ordinances. Motion carried.

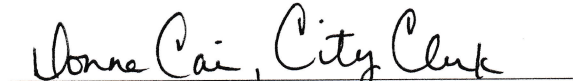
Adjournment
